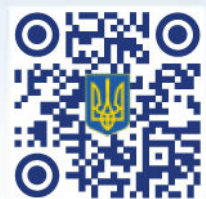
We would like to help you settle into your NEW HOME here in Germany, both professionally and personally, for a real NEW START:
